



The Mary Jennings Sport Camp Scholarship is an initiative of **The Playing for Power Project (P4P2)**, a non-profit organization whose mission is to encourage girls' participation and leadership in and through sports.

The scholarship is named in honor of Mary Jennings, a multi-sport scholar-athlete from Piscataway, NJ. Mary was diagnosed with liver cancer in 2006 at the age of 21 and passed away shortly thereafter.

In honor of her lifelong involvement in sport and success as a student-athlete, the Mary Jennings Sport Camp Scholarship was created to support girls ages 9-13 in their skill development by attending a sports camp of their choice.

Scholarship winners are chosen by a committee.
